<b>Aim of Residency:</b>			
<p>In this five-day residency where participants will be introduced to stained glass as a craft form. They will develop a practical understanding of the materials, tools and processes required to produce a small stained-glass panel to a professional standard.</p> <p>The residency will encompass basic design, composing a cutline, glass selection, glass cutting, glass painting, kiln firing, leading, soldering, and cementing through practical demonstrations.</p> <p>The participants will be required to work alongside our staff and students and to give a lecture on their Craft.</p>
